Ryburgh Memorial Hall & Playing Field Code of Conduct

1. Purpose

- Avoid engaging in any activity that could harm themselves or others.

5. Safeguarding

Volunteers must:

- Adhere to safeguarding policies, especially when working with children or vulnerable adults.
- Report any concerns or incidents to the designated safeguarding officer.

6. Use of Charity Resources

Volunteers must:

- Use charity resources responsibly and only for intended purposes.
- Avoid misuse of equipment, funds, or information.

7. Anti-Discrimination and Harassment

Volunteers must:

- Not engage in any form of discrimination, harassment, or bullying.
- Promote an inclusive and welcoming environment.

8. Social Media and Public Representation

Volunteers must:

- Represent the charity positively in public and online.
- Avoid posting inappropriate or harmful content related to the charity.

9. Disciplinary Action

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in:

- Verbal or written warnings.
- Suspension or termination of volunteer role.
